Investor Alert for Stratus Financial Group International

Halifax - The Nova Scotia Securities Commission is alerting investors that Stratus Financial Group International (Stratus) is not registered to sell securities in Nova Scotia.

The company and its representatives have solicited at least one Nova Scotia resident by telephone to invest in natural gas futures.

Stratus is also the subject of a [warning in New Brunswick](#) on similar activities.

The Commission urges Nova Scotians to exercise extreme caution when dealing with firms that are not registered in Nova Scotia. It is illegal to solicit investments in Nova Scotia without registering with the Commission and complying with Nova Scotia securities laws. To see if a company or person is registered, you can check the [Canadian Securities Administrators'](#) National Registration Search.
