Investor Alert for UFX.com, ufxmarkets.com and Reliantco

Halifax - The Nova Scotia Securities Commission is cautioning investors about UFX.com, ufxmarkets.com and Reliantco, which are offering online trading and binary options to Nova Scotians. The Commission is alerting investors that UFX.com, ufxmarkets.com and Reliantco are not registered to sell securities in Nova Scotia.

At least one Nova Scotian responded to a Facebook advertisement, used a credit card, and lost a significant sum of money.

A similar warning has been issued in <u>Manitoba</u>. The Canadian Securities Administrators issued a general warning relating to <u>binary options</u> in March.

The Commission urges Nova Scotians to exercise extreme caution when dealing with firms that are not registered in Nova Scotia. It is illegal to solicit investments in Nova Scotia without registering with the Commission and complying with Nova Scotia securities laws. To see if a company or person is registered, you can check at aretheyregistered.ca, the Canadian Investors protect themselves.
