Investor Alert for Wesley Robinson and DRR900306 N.S. Limited

Halifax - The Nova Scotia Securities Commission is alerting investors that Wesley Robinson and DRR900306 N.S. Limited are not registered to sell securities in Nova Scotia.

Mr. Robinson and DRR900306 N.S. Limited have solicited investments from Nova Scotians in exchange for promissory notes and project funding agreements. Mr. Robinson has also claimed to participate in a by-invitation-only trading platform offering investors short term investments with high rates of return. He has been promoting his operations on LinkedIn.com.

"Online advertising services can be a dangerous place to shop for investments. Always take time to check registration and understand the risks and costs associated with your investment," warns Jennie Pick, enforcement counsel for the Commission.

The Commission urges Nova Scotians to exercise extreme caution when dealing with anyone that is not registered in Nova Scotia. It is illegal to solicit investments in Nova Scotia without registering with the Commission and complying with Nova Scotia securities laws. To see if a company or person is registered, you can check the [Canadian Securities Administrators'](#) National Registration Search.
