

NOVA SCOTIA SECURITIES COMMISSION

**RULE 11-508 (AMENDMENT)
AMENDMENTS TO THE
FEES SCHEDULES IN THE GENERAL SECURITIES RULES**

PART 1 - DEFINITIONS

- 1.1 “General Securities Rules”, as defined in Rule 14-501 Definitions, means the rules deemed by subsection 150A(9) of the Act to have been made pursuant to section 150 of the Act, as amended from time to time.

PART 2 – AMENDMENTS TO THE FEES SCHEDULES

- 2.1 Appendix A of the General Securities Rules is amended by deleting subsection 11(4) in Appendix A, Schedule 1 - Fees and replacing it with the following:

“11. (4) Any annual information form filed under Nova Scotia securities laws shall be accompanied by a fee of \$1400.20. However, for annual information forms filed after April 16, 2020 and before June 30, 2020, submission of the fee may be deferred until June 30, 2020.”.

- 2.2 Appendix A of the General Securities Rules is amended by deleting section 13 in Appendix A, Schedule 1 - Fees and replacing it with the following:

“13. The annual financial statements filed by each issuer under Nova Scotia securities laws shall be accompanied by a fee of \$175.15 except that where the issuer has securities listed and posted for trading on a stock exchange in Canada, the fee is \$291.45. However, for annual financial statements filed after April 16, 2020 and before June 30, 2020, submission of the fee may be deferred until June 30, 2020.”.

PART 3 - EFFECTIVE DATE

- 3.1 This rule shall take effect, with the approval and specification of the Minister under subsection 150A(4) of the Act, on **April 23, 2020**, unless the Minister disapproves the rule or returns it to the Commission in accordance with subsection 150A(3) of the Act in which event the rule shall not be effective until the rule is approved by the Minister.
