<u>ORDER</u>

WHEREAS the Nova Scotia Securities Commission (Commission) held a hearing in writing to consider a motion brought by Wesley William Robinson and DRR900306 NS Ltd. for a postponement of a hearing by videoconference scheduled to commence on February 10, 2021 pursuant to an Amended Notice of Hearing dated December 22, 2020 (the Hearing);

AND WHEREAS a temporary order imposing certain sanctions on the Respondents pursuant to sections 134(1)(a)(i), 134(1)(b)(ii), 134(1)(c), 134(1)(e)(i), and 134(1)(g) of the Act (Temporary Order) is in effect until the earlier of (i) the date on which a hearing is held and the decision rendered; and (ii) February 26, 2021;

AND WHEREAS the Director of Enforcement (Director) and the Respondents applied for an extension of the Temporary Order;

AND WHEREAS after considering the affidavit evidence submitted in support of the application the Commission is of the opinion that it is necessary and in the public interest to extend the Temporary Order;

AND ON READING the written submissions of the Director and the Respondents;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, for reasons to follow, that:

- 1. the Hearing is postponed until April 19, 2021;
- 2. the Hearing will be held from 9:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. each day on the following dates, or so soon thereafter as the Hearing can be held:
 - April 19, 20, 26, 27, and May 3 and 4;
- the Respondents shall provide to the Director their requisite disclosure pursuant to part 8.3 of Rule 15-501 on or before March 5, 2021, after which no documents will be entered nor evidence or witnesses called without leave of the Commission;

- 4. the Respondents shall file any pre-hearing motions, including further adjournment requests, on or before March 19, 2021;
- 5. the Director shall file a pre-hearing brief on or before March 29, 2021;
- 6. the Respondents shall file a pre-hearing brief on or before April 13, 2021;
- 7. the Temporary Order is extended until the earlier of (i) the date on which a hearing is held and the decision rendered; and (ii) May 4, 2021.
