Amendments to Blanket Order No. 51-505

IN THE MATTER OF THE SECURITIES ACT, R.S.N.S. 1989, CHAPTER 418, AS AMENDED (the Act)

-AND-

IN THE MATTER OF AN EXEMPTION FROM THE REQUIREMENT TO SEND FINANCIAL STATEMENTS AND RELATED DISCLOSURE TO SECURITYHOLDERS DURING A DISRUPTION IN POSTAL SERVICE

ORDER (SECTION 151A)

WHEREAS:

- 1. The Commission made Blanket Order No. 51-505 Exemption from the Requirement to Send Financial Statements and Related Disclosure to Securityholders During a Disruption to Postal Service, effective June 1, 2011 (the Blanket Order);
- 2. Amendments to the Blanket Order are required in connection with the introduction of the System for Electronic Data Analysis and Retrieval + (SEDAR+) by the Commission and one or more of the Canadian securities regulatory authorities; and
- 3. The Commission is satisfied that it would not be prejudicial to the public interest to amend the Blanket Order.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED, pursuant to subsection 151A(1) of the Act, that:

- 1. Nova Scotia Securities Commission Blanket Order No . 51-505 Exemption from the Requirement to Send Financial Statements and Related Disclosure to Securityholders During a Disruption in Postal Service is amended by this Order as follows:
 - a. Subsection 1(c)(i)(a) is amended by replacing "SEDAR website at www.sedar.com" with "SEDAR+ website at www.sedarplus.com".
 - b. Subsection 2(c)(i) is amended by replacing "SEDAR website at www.sedar.com" with "SEDAR+ website at www.sedarplus.com".
- 2. This Order comes into force on June 9, 2023.
