Blanket Order No. 29

IN THE MATTER OF THE SECURITIES ACT, R.S.N.S. 1989, CHAPTER 418, AS AMENDED

AND -

IN THE MATTER OF THE DEFINITIONS OF A LOAN COMPANY AND OF A TRUST COMPANY

ORDER (Clause 3(3)(a) of the Securities Regulations)

WHEREAS:

- Under clause 3(1)(b) of the Securities Regulations, a "loan company" is defined in part by reference to a company governed by the <u>Loan Companies Act</u>, S.N.S. 1989, Chapter 269;
- 2. Under clause 3(1)(c) of the Securities Regulations, a "trust company" is defined in part by reference to a company governed by the <u>Trust Companies Act</u>, S.N.S. 1989, Chapter 478;
- The <u>Trust and Loan Companies Act</u>, S.N.S. 1991, Chapter was proclaimed on December 18, 1991 and came into force on January 1, 1992 and repealed the <u>Loan Companies</u> Act supra and the <u>Trust Companies Act supra</u>;
- 4. Under the <u>Trust and Loan Companies Act</u>, any company conducting, undertaking or transacting the business



of a loan company or a trust company in Nova Scotia is required to be licensed under that Act;

5. The Commission is satisfied that to make this order would not be prejudicial to the public interest.

IT IS ORDERED, pursuant to clause 3(3)(a) of the Securities Regulations, that:

- (a) a company licensed under the <u>Trust and Loan Companies Act</u> to conduct the business of a loan company is prescribed to be a "loan company" for the purpose of the Act provided that it is a member institution within the meaning of the <u>Canada Deposit Insurance Corporation Act</u>; and
- (b) a company licensed under the <u>Trust and Loan Companies Act</u> to conduct the business of a trust company is prescribed to be a "trust company" for the purpose of the Act provided that it is a member institution within the meaning of the <u>Canada Deposit Insurance Corporation Act</u>.
