

Blanket Order No. 11-502

IN THE MATTER OF THE *SECURITIES ACT*,  
R.S.N.S. 1989, CHAPTER 418, AS AMENDED (the Act)

ORDER  
(Section 151)

WHEREAS:

1. As a result of amendments to Nova Scotia securities laws, the following Blanket Orders (the Blanket Orders) are no longer required and can be revoked:
  - a. Blanket Order No. 14 In the Matter of Trades in Securities of Certain Closely Held Companies;
  - b. Blanket Order No. 19 In the Matter of Applications Pursuant to Subsection 67(5) of the Act;
  - c. In the Matter of Local Policy No. 34-601;
  - d. Blanket Order No. 36 In the Matter of an Exemption for Certain Take-Over Bids and Issuer Bids;
  - e. Blanket Order No. 37 (as varied) In the Matter of Trades in Securities of a Company to Another Company in Connection with an Amalgamation, an Arrangement or a Specified Statutory Procedure;
  - f. Blanket Order No. 39 In the Matter of Expedited Review of Short Form Prospectuses and Renewal AIFs;
  - g. Blanket Order No. 43A In the Matter of Exemptions from Certain Insider Report Requirements with Respect to the Acquisition of Securities Under an Employee Share Purchase or Stock Option Plan;
  - h. Blanket Order No. 51-505 In the Matter of Rule 51-102 Continuous Disclosure Obligations and Rule 81-106 Investment Fund Continuous Disclosure;
  - i. Blanket Order No. 54-502 In the Matter of Rule 54-101 Communication with Beneficial Owners of Securities of a Reporting Issuer; and

- j. Blanket Order No. 62-501 In the Matter of Rule 62-104 Take-Over Bids and Issuer Bids;
2. Pursuant to section 151 of the Act, the Commission may, where in its opinion to do so would not be prejudicial to the public interest, make an order revoking any decision made under the Act or the regulations; and
3. The Commission is of the opinion that to do so would not be prejudicial to the public interest.

IT IS ORDERED pursuant to section 151 of the Act that the Blanket Orders are revoked.
