Order
(Sections 134(1) and 134(1A) of the Act)

WHEREAS the Director of Enforcement for the Nova Scotia Securities Commission ("Commission") submitted a Notice of Application dated the 24th day of July, 2015;

AND WHEREAS the Respondent was provided an opportunity to be heard by way of written response;

AND WHEREAS the Respondent did not provide a written response to this application;

AND WHEREAS proper service was effected upon the Respondent and an Affidavit of Service was filed with the Commission;

AND UPON reviewing and considering the submissions of counsel for the Director of Enforcement;

AND UPON the Nova Scotia Provincial Court having convicted the Respondent of eight criminal offences arising from a transaction, business or course of action related to securities, as noted in the Decision issued April 12, 2010;

AND UPON the Commission determining it is in the public interest to issue this order pursuant to section 134(1A)(a) of the Act;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

1. Pursuant to subsection 134(1)(b) of the Act, that the Respondent cease trading in Nova Scotia, except on his own behalf through a registrant of the Commission, permanently;
2. Pursuant to subsection 134(1)(c) of the Act, that any exemptions contained in Nova Scotia securities laws do not apply to the Respondent permanently;
3. Pursuant to subsection 134(1)(d)(ii) of the Act, that the Respondent be prohibited from becoming or acting as a director or officer of any issuer permanently; and
4. Pursuant to subsection 134(1)(f) of the Act, that the registration of the Respondent be cancelled; and

5. Pursuant to subsection 134(1)(g) of the Act, that the Respondent be prohibited from becoming or acting as a registrant, investment fund manager or promoter permanently.
