CONSENT ORDER

WHEREAS an Investigation Order [the "Investigation Order"] was issued by the Nova Scotia Securities Commission [the "Commission"] on July 20, 2010, following an *ex parte* application by the Director of Enforcement for the Commission;

AND WHEREAS Part 3.10 of Rule 15-501 *General Rules of Practice and Procedure* ["Rule 15-501"] provides that any affidavits filed with the Secretary in support of an *ex parte* application shall not be public documents unless otherwise ordered by the Commission;

AND WHEREAS the Respondent Douglas G. Rudolph has moved for disclosure of the affidavit evidence filed by Commission enforcement staff in support of obtaining the Investigation Order [the "Affidavit Evidence"] on the basis the Affidavit Evidence is relevant to his intended defence;

AND WHEREAS production of the Affidavit Evidence may assist in narrowing the issues to be determined at the hearing on the merits of the allegations;

AND WHEREAS pursuant to Part 8.4 of Rule 15-501 a party may seek an order of disclosure in advance of a hearing and the Commission may, pursuant to Part 18.2 of Rule 15-501, issue general or specific procedural directions at any time before or during a hearing;

AND WHEREAS Ian Gray, counsel for Peter A.D. Mill; Christopher Robinson, counsel for Douglas G. Rudolph; and Jennie Pick, counsel for the Director of Enforcement for the Commission, consent to the terms of this Order;

AND UPON the Commission determining it is in the public interest to make this Order;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

1. An electronic copy of the Affidavit Evidence shall be produced to counsel for the Respondents Douglas Rudolph and Peter Mill;
2. A copy of the Affidavit Evidence shall be produced to the Respondents CFG*CN Limited and CanGlobe International Capital Inc. should those

Respondents request a copy of the disclosure of the Director of Enforcement as specified in the Commission's Order of April 10, 2014; and

3. Further to the Commission's Order of April 10, 2014, the parties to the within proceeding shall keep the Affidavit Evidence confidential, other than for the purposes of this proceeding, unless otherwise ordered.

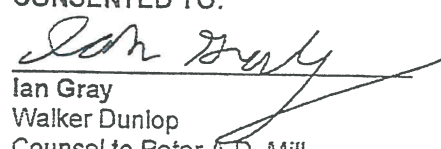
