ORDER

(Section 33(1) of the Act and Section 9.2 of the Securities Commission General Rules of Practice and Procedure (the “Rules of Practice and Procedure”))

WHEREAS UPON HEARING the Exparte Application of Staff (the “Application”), it appears to the Nova Scotia Securities Commission (the ACommission@) that the Respondent, being a registrant under the Act, has conducted himself in a manner which is contrary to the public interest and in contravention of the Act;

AND WHEREAS THE RESPONDENT waives his opportunity to be heard pursuant to section 33(1) of the Act;

AND WHEREAS THE Commission is of the opinion it is in the public interest to make this order;

IT IS ORDERED pursuant to section 33(1) of the Act that the Respondent-s registration is suspended until such time as the Commission makes a further order in respect thereto.

AND WHEREAS THE Commission is of the opinion that the public inspection of any of the documents (the Adocuments@) filed with or sent to the Commission in support of the Application would be unduly prejudicial to a person or persons who have status in the investigation of K.H.I. or to a witness or witnesses and that it would not be contrary to the public interest to make this further order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED pursuant to section 9.2 of the Rules of Practice and Procedure that the documents not be open for public inspection.
