AND WHEREAS Raymond Courtney is an interested party in this proceeding;

AND WHEREAS the Commission conducted a hearing on the Motions on July 25, 2006 having heard from Dan Potter on behalf of himself and Knowledge House Inc., Dale Dunlop on behalf of Kenneth G. MacLeod and Calvin Wadden, Tim Hill on behalf of Raymond Courtney and Heidi Schedler on behalf of Staff of the Commission;

AND WHEREAS the Commission issued an Order in this matter on January 17, 2007 ("January Order");

AND WHEREAS the Commission convened a pre-hearing conference pursuant to section 9.1 of Rule 15-501 of the General Rules of Practice and Procedure on August 8,

AND WHEREAS Staff requested and received 9 Emailboxes from the Knowledge House Inc. server, during the course of the investigation, from lawyers acting for National Bank Financial Ltd. ("Emailboxes");

AND WHEREAS pursuant to section 29A of the Securities Act, R.S.N.S. 1989, c. 418 ("Act") Staff cannot disclose any information, documents or other things obtained under section 27 of the Act without an order of the Commission;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED pursuant to section 29AA(1)(b) of the Act that:

- No later than September 7, 2007, Staff shall provide Dan Potter, Kenneth G. MacLeod, Calvin Wadden and Raymond Courtney or their legal counsel with copies of all documents printed from the Emailboxes, a list of the emails that were used during the investigation, including how and when the emails were used, and any other documents relating to Staff's access and use of the Emailboxes.
- 2. "Documents" includes a sound recording, photograph, film, plan, chart, graph, and any information generated, recorded or stored by means of any device, including, but not limited to, computers and digital media, but excludes documents that are subject to privilege.
