Cease Trade Order Issued Against The Sou'Wester Wind Field Inc.

Halifax - The Nova Scotia Securities Commission has found that The Sou'Wester Wind Field Inc. violated Nova Scotia securities laws.

The company, a Nova Scotia community economic-development corporation, has not filed continuous disclosure documents.

The director of corporate finance ordered Sou'Wester to comply with Nova Scotia securities laws and ordered all people and companies to permanently cease trading in securities of Sou'Wester.
